- 1) Rain showers continuing today - "between storms" - as moist unstable air continues to flow through So Cal. Heavy activity in Hacienda Heights / San Gabriel Valley / Orange area with some very heavy rain reports - over an inch in less than an hour.
- 2) Another strong, wet frontal passage - about 11 am. West of U. Heavy rain showers ahead of the front, only a few light showers after. Numerous mudslides, creek flooding, street flooding a.m. - especially Santa Monica thru Ventura etc. Flash flood watches + warnings galore. First break from nearly continuous rain after about 3 pm. Through the evening with only mostly cloudy skies. Not very windy.
- 3) Brief batch of Thunderstorms + Tstorms 2-4 am, with hail some areas - several nearby lightning strikes gusty wind to 29 mph - partly to mostly cloudy during day with sprinkles here - some heavier showers elsewhere, mostly near areas in unstable air from PG 17. Twice as much rain Chatsworth than here.
- 4) Some showers afternoon - mostly light, near mtns. Rain beginning here around 2:30. Flash flood watch issued 2:30 for S.B., Vent, Cit. County as a colder front bears down from on So Cal from the NW. Heavy rain today SFO area. Fl. Fl. Watch for midnight to 1200 on 15th. Funnel clouds observed today over ocean off of SBA + SAN, due to moist, unstable atmosphere.
- 5) Frontal passage ~ 0830 w/ winds to 38 + heavy showers, clearing by 1000
