- 1) Upper low SW of L.A. moving slowly E.
- 2) Upper low still WSW of L.A. most of moisture headed NE towards AZ. Surface high Gr. Basin for NE winds - locally very strong - Newhall Pass, Laguna Plc. eq. Sprinkles here before mt, light-mod shower just after mt.
- 3) Upper low moving into deserts with $\frac{1}{2}$ - $\frac{3}{4}$ " rain most of So Cal. Strong storm expected to develop off of Ca coast Sun - 5th.
- 4) Strong, cold storm off N. Calif w/ cold front passage thru L.A. today 1 to 2 inches rain most areas today - heavy snow level mtns + Sierra. not much wind - few T storms + hail - but not in SFV.
- 5) Strong upper low moving SSE along Ca coast - mod. rain here during day - ending \approx 1700. Clear by 1900 w/ inc NE winds 10-20 PG 25. Daytime high 47, - 41° early eve then 48 by mt with wind. Snow closed 1-5, Hwy 14 late aft.
- 6) Ridge over So Cal, Mod offshore grads - N. Wind NSFU. 87 San Gabriel Hottest in nation - 85 LACU trial record High
- 7) NE winds beginning mid-eve; 7-17 PG 30; Aft W Brz PG 12
- 8) NE winds all night & day, dying near sunset PG 30 night, 40 day
