- 7) Hurricane Darby downgraded to a T. St. Midday -  
 $\approx$  600 mi SSW of L.A. + moving WNW 18 mph  
 high level outflow directly NE over L.A. +  
 So. California - and all the way to Colo + Wyo.  
 Light rain + sprinkles mainly San Diego area  
 + Inland Empire today.  
 Late evening - 2305 - 2320 Van Nuys to Woodland  
 Hills - temp 76 to 73 along 101 Freeway -  
 with occ spkls from high overcast
- 8) Light showers. Midday + late aft.  
 some drg late eve. - few point mid-upper 60s  
 Very light winds - mostly ENE 2-4  
 T.S. Parby downgraded to a T.D -  
 $\approx$  650 mi SSW of SAN eve. + still moving NW  
 Muggy afternoon + muggier evening here
- 12) Low level remnants from Darby continue with a  
 weak trough over Ca. - high dew points continue -  
 upper 60s + overcast days - 11th + 12th with  
 some light drizzle even midday - much more precip other  
 areas of L.A. - over one inch Mt Wilson  
 1/4 - 1/2 inch San Gabriel Valley
- 14) Continued humid w/ dew points low-mid 60s  
 Upper low west of L.A. drifting west is  
 Upper high over Mexico pushes north for  
 sunnier weather. SW flow aloft beginning  
 to admet moisture from dying Harr. EST. -  
 moving N to NW and  $\approx$  700 mi west of  
 Cabo San Lucas evening of 14th.
- 18) Large Upper High over N. Baja - 107 Van Nuys
- 30) Desert Moisture increasing with late eve storms  
 E. Deserts.
