- 1) Disturbance from the SW moving quickly through Cal off shore w/ lots of clouds but little precip.  
Stronger storm continues to develop 1200 mi W. of LA.
- 2) Squall line moving NNE thru West L.A. County @ 1700-1800 w/ heavy Tstorms - esp. Encino w/ .98" in 50 min. -- Flash flood warning issued for W. + N. LA. County until 8 pm. 3/4" hail reported in SFV.  
3.99" Encino from x 0500 to 1800  
Very vigorous low pressure area several hundred miles west of LA. - strong + wet cold front moving through late morning - followed by light to mod rain, then heavy Tstorms near sunset - windy evening - South to WSW winds 10 to 25 gusts to 36
- Wind gusts to 93 mph @ Mt. Wilson early evening  
Winter St. Warning for mtns above 7-8000 ft.
- 22) Trough digging south along West Coast - not much of a surface low associated with it. Weak cold front through area evening hours with mostly light rain.
- 23) Cold front passage late AM - rain mod - heavy morning hours. 1.48 here, 0.99 Encino; weak tornado AZUSA  
Sunnel clouds Bakersfield area
- 27) Upper low aloft drifting South through Calif. - hail in Palmdale Newbury Pl + Camarillo mid-late afternoon.
- 28) Threatening sky late aft - but fizzled; - showers over San Gabriel Mtns aft.
