- (2) cont. - NE winds along coast here from Pt. Mugu to Long Beach - gusts to 30 mph. N^w winds at Van Nuys pulling in cold air from interior - high here during day only 47. - ~~E~~ late eve temp 47 as warm front approaches. Thunder heard L.A. area midday. Most coastal areas received $\frac{1}{2}$ to 1 inch.
- (3) Brief heavy TShower ≈ 2310 with several flashes & Thunder - moving east. S to SW Wind with storm - 7 to 17 mph, gust to 26 @ Mt.
- (4) Rain very early AM - then just mostly clouds to partly cloudy during day but no rain - until about midnight w/ s/p/c/s as leading edge of large swath of sub-tropical moisture @ mid & high levels approaches SoCal from SW. Upper low continues w of Oregon.
- (7) Upper low w. of C. Calif finally moving ^{slowly} ~~on shore~~ towards coast w/bands of rain & Tstorms.
 Winter Storm Wg for mtns
 Flood Warning for all coastal SoCal
 Tornado Watch for all coastal SoCal beg. late eve to 4am. on 18th. (2 weak tornados already touched down - in Ora. Cty & Riv. Cty.)
 Very heavy TStorm Van Nuys & vicinity ≈ 2330
- (8) Tornado Watch extended to 4 p.m. today as heavy lines of Tstorms develop off the coast & swing inland.
 Tornado moved onshore Hunt. Beach
 Flood Watcher canceled as upper low moves thru L.A. & east of area evening.
 Tornado skipped through Lake Forest near Mission Viejo -
 Flooding along Murrieta R. in Temecula & Murrieta
 mudslides in numerous areas.
