- 2) Wk - Mod offshore flow, reaching downtown -- L.A. CC. 94° - trying hottest Feb temp ever there. L.A., Mon, San Gab. Hottest in
- 3) Surface offshore flow continues w/ warm ridge over CA 94° again L.A. CC.
- 4) L.A. 91 - another record! Offshore flow weak, fog along coast
- 5) foggy beaches as off shore flow weak further; 81 @ LACC
- 7) Lt. Shows L.A. area late eve., 855 oc w/wk upper low near SFO
- 8) Cold trough + vert max dropping South along PAC NW, and abundant subtropical moisture passed SW of CA.
- 14) SSW winds to 17 mph early AM w/shower as cold front moves SE through here. MWS - over 6" w/storm - flooding C. AZ. BP. 29.60; GV, light winds behind front
- 19) Mod SA condition - 91 LACC, 90 @ SAN; 92 TRM San 78° @ 11 p.m w/East Brz 6 knots
- 20) 95° @ LACC, Monrovia, + Santa Ana -- record hi for Feb @ LACC. - Rec Antillo of 63 LACC 93 @ TRM ) Santa Ana winds diminishing late aft Upper Low over N. Baja caused showers + showers to develop during the late aft + eve from about SAN to LAX. Frequent lightning SAN late eve showers moving to the NW, just S of SFV.
- 24) Upper low (that caused activity on 20th) moved back west from AZ/WM towards So Cal + caused numerous showers/storms local mtns/deserts, with some in coastal/valley areas, too.
