- 4) Strong neg. tilt trough slams into C. & S. CA from the West with about 12 to 16 hrs of mod-heavy rain all of SoCal. Numerous watches, warnings, etc. Snow in Ant. Valley, Owens Vly. Strong E winds SFV + coast - about 20-30 mph. Rain letting up here eve. - daytime high temp 50 - West winds here late eve bumped high to 53. Surface low moved in near SMX and thru FAT. Low RP here 29.63
4 to 6 inches rain coastal sections Santa Monica to Ora. Cty. Lots of Urban street flooding. - Fl. Fl. Wngs for Attadema, Malibu, Laguna burn areas
- 7) Another wet front - falling out over S. L.A. + Ora. Cty with another 2-3 inches there. Not much wind with this system here, but quite strong N. Ca.
- 8) Strong S winds again SAC Valley - gusts to 60 mph and days a row of Redding. Flooding in Napa, Marin + Sonoma Cty - Russian River flooding. - Between storms here - but nearly continuous R- or drizzle anyway. Light winds - rising temps with dew points appr. 60.
- 10) Strong wet "cold" front slowly moving east thru SoCal today. Record 24 hr rainfall for Santa Barbara - 7 1/2" from 8 p.m. on 9th to 8 p.m. on 10th. About 12" today San Marcos Pass. 5.3" Pasadena. Widespread urban flooding + flash flooding local canyons. High snow level - 7000' or higher. Strong SE winds along coast - SE 40 knots Newport Pch @ 4 p.m. w/c winds here. Rain let up here @ 1600, but light showers returned + persisted thru the evening. Other WH gage reportedly caught 5.94" thru 4 p.m.
- 14) Wk front thru SoCal eve w/ lt rain. - Stronger C. Cal. w/ Tstorms + weak tornados near Chowchilla.
