- 6) Strong Upper high still over SoCal, but beginning to weaken a little. moist low level surge from the south causing eddy-like whirls and slightly cooler conditions - but more humid gradient TRM to LA weakly offshore late a.m., with 72°F dew point at TRM. Lots of flat cir over mtns, w/some over valley
- 7) Severe storms Mohave Cty AZ mid-late aft. w/ tornado warning for a cell near Needles
- 8) Severe storm w/ fl. warning Newberry Sprs (E of DAA) ~1500
- 18) Remains of TS + TD Ignacio continue to move Northward, west of Southern Baptist W of SoCal late. Band of mid-high level clouds moving N through L.A. XTU/SBA counties ~ midnight with little or no precip.
- 19) Remains of Ignacio moving N just NW of Pt. Conception, mid^{night} causing SFO area storms + showers and causing humid + breezy (E to SE) conditions L.A. area. Gusts to 40 mph Laguna Peak + Saddle Peak. Southerly Winds to 35 mph causing blowing dust S. SFO near Lamont. Highs near or above 90°F beaches
- 20) Ignacio moving rapidly N thru No Cal + Pac NW. About an inch at SFO - making this the wettest August on record there.
