- 2) Storm moving SE thru SoCal today. -- at 3:15 pm. --  
 San Doppler showed a band of storms + hail showers  
 along S. SAN city coast near Imp. Beh. moving  
 SE @ 25 mph to 40 mph + a waterspout 0.5 mi  
 off of Scripps Pier were reported  
 6" snow @ MWS; 10" San Jacinto Mtns (Pike Cove)

A second "wave" moving through from WNW with  
 another 0.22" here  $\approx$  2100-2200. Several rumbles  
 of thunder  $\approx$  2200 here; light winds  
 Arctic front continues to push south + west out  
 of Nevada, reaching Bishop by evening.

Bishop at 06Z - + Wind 350 @ 21 0-29, pk wind 31 km  
 Temp/dw pt -04/-08 (24F/18F) light snow  
 RDD + RBL 2C (36F) w/north winds 20 knts @ 06Z  
 RLU temp -11C (13F) @ 06Z, wind 060 @ 14 knts @ 23

 above 3500' with this second wave.
