

Sept. 1997

- 1) Deep, moist southerly flow thru deserts + mtns from E SAN County north. Very heavy, severe cell E of 29 Palms -- washing out Road 62. Gusts to 86 mph 29 Palms AP.
- 2) Southerly moist flow continuing over So Cal, with an upper level disturbed moving North thru the area to help convection. AM T showers off of So Cal coast moving north into W SFCU @ 0230 -- brief heavy here 0230 for about 20 seconds -- more thunder + sprinkles thru 0700. SBA -- 3 consecutive hours with Thunder @ m.

Strong afternoon T storms Mtns + deserts -- especially near Lucerne Valley + Borstow. Tennis-ball to baseball-sized hail N of Borstow. Storm visible from here from ~1600 - 1930, with frequent lightning in cloud tops.

Another "pulse" severe + storm near WJT @ 1400

- 3) Moist S flow aloft - + storms over N reports have "worked" the low-levels over -- max of LAs only ~~at~~ W offshore flow but quite humid LA area. SUR storms N of Borstow again mid-off; eve by T stormst fl fl wryg E Kern County / Mojave area.

L.A. -- no rain again, 198 straight with zero rain (no measurable), breaking the 197 straight in 1927.

Eureka -- record 14th straight day with max of 70° or higher! Old record was 7 straight.
