24) cont) west of Pt. Conception is resulting in
 storms + showers over the coastal waters
 today, esp. west of a line from Pt. Con to San
 Clemente Island. Some sprinkles and showers
 in the SAN mid-afternoon.

A FL Flood watch has been issued by SAN
 for the 24th for the SAN, RIV, + SBD cty
 mtns + deserts.

Towards midnight, Nora near Punta Eugenia, moving
 N @ 17 mph, winds 70 knots.

Large swath of mid-level moisture over all of
 SoCal w/lt showers + spkls many stations

No measurable rain at L.A. - record will probably
 end on 25th.

25) Nora moving north over Yuma around 2 pm as
 a tropical storm - 45 mph winds, N at 25 mph -
 weakening rapidly, heavy showers east of center
 is SW AZ - just 11" - max rain L.A. area
 0.45" L.A. Cf. 1st Laguna in SAN County
 Some flooding S. deserts but no major problems
 or flash flooding.

Rain @ L.A., ending dry streak which
 began on Feb 18th.
